Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct below is the convention of rules accepted by the committee and members of Leichhardt SFC as acceptable conduct for players, coaches and or members and supporters of our club. These rules are to be accepted by everybody involved and will be expected to comply with its conventions. It is understood that a breach of these rules will result in that individual being held accountable for their actions and accept the final decision of the committee.

Player conduct

- 1 A player shall conduct themselves in a gentlemanly conduct
- 2 The following behaviour will not be accepted:
 - a. Foul language
 - b. Racial abuse
 - c. Discrimination
 - d. Assault
 - e. Battery
 - f. Inter- team Assaults
 - g. And any our behaviour which is socially unacceptable.
- 3 Players will be asked to participate within the rules of the playing associations: CDSFA and or Sydney Amateur League
- 4 Any player cited by a referee and referred to the league via red or yellow card and or formal report shall be deemed on report within the Leichhardt SFC rules.
 - a. All Red cards will receive a suspension from the League. The LSFC committee will review each incident and if so required defended the player at their league hearing.
 - b. The red card fine shall be paid by the player directly to LSFC. \$40
 - c. If the committee so chooses the suspended period maybe longer than that imposed by the league.
 - d. Any yellow card offence shall incur a fine and that fine will be paid by the player directly to LSFC. \$20
 - e. Double yellow cards will incur a suspension and a fine payable directly to LSFC. \$20 x 2
 - f. Accumulation of points (3 yellow cards during a season) will result in a suspension by the league. A fine shall be payable by the player directly to LSFC.\$10
 - g. Any player expelled by the league will be also be expelled by LSFC.
 - h. All fines must be paid prior to taking the field again.
- 5 No fee refund is possible if you are suspended or expelled from the league or association.



- 6 Alcohol is not permitted before or during a game or training session. The responsible use of alcohol is to be observed after a game and or training session.
- 7 Shouting from the sideline is to be positive only, no directions other than those assigned to give instruction shall do so.
- 8 Abusive behaviour and or abusing referees and or officials is not accepted and will be dealt with by the LSFC committee.
- 9 Ropes are there for a reason and only managers, coaches and substitutes shall be are permitted in this area. Others are to stand behind the ropes (visible and invisible).
- 10 Resolution of disputes shall be submitted to the committee and will be resolved at the next scheduled committee meeting. All disputes shall be resolved in line with the constitution of the LSFC Club.(as per Section 19 of the Constitution)
- 11 All fines and suspensions and decisions are at the discretion of the LSFC committee.
